The Manager of W.I.S.E. – SSE 50 China Tracker[®] (*This is a synthetic ETF) (the “**Fund**”) would like to announce that Standard & Poor’s Ratings Services (“**S&P**”) has downgraded the credit rating of Credit Suisse International (“**Credit Suisse**”).

Credit Suisse is an AXP issuer of the Fund.

S&P has downgraded the Long-term Issuer Credit Rating of Credit Suisse from A+ to A.

As at the date of this Announcement, the long term credit rating of Credit Suisse remains above the minimum credit rating requirement as disclosed in the Prospectus.
