Manager's Comment ▲

- In February, the CSI 300 Index rose by 9.35%.
- China's equity market had a soft rebound on hopes of improving travel data and official supports The travel and spending boom during Spring Festival holiday showed improved sentiment among Chinese consumers and fully illuminated the vitality and vast potential of China's consumption market. The total domestic tourism spending jumped by 47.3% year-on-year (YoY) to about CNY 632.69 billion. The PBoC cut 5-year loan prime rate (LPR) to 3.95% from 4.20% and left the oneyear LPR unchanged at 3.45%
- China's official manufacturing purchasing managers' index (PMI) fell to 49.1 in February from 49.2
- USD appreciated against CNY from 7.1689 at the end of January to 7.1886 at the end of February. The Producer Price Index (PPI) for manufactured goods fell by 2.5% (YoY) in January, compared with a 2.7% YoY drop in the previous month
- In January, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) decreased by 0.8% year-on-year (YoY), compared with a 0.3% drop in the previous month. Food prices, the main contributors to the CPI, dropped
